Welcome to our multicultural church at 10 am Our Guest Preacher is Pastor Cyrus Kung

Psalm 78:1-4, 12-16*

The opening verses of this long psalm set out the psalmist's purpose: to remind the people of Israel of their history and of how God had cared for them and also of how the nation had not always learned from what God had done. In many ways it juxtaposes (or puts side by side) God's faithfulness and Israel's infidelity and failure. The point of all this is to encourage future generations to put their trust in God and to learn from past failures. The teaching to which the people are to pay attention concerns both their history and the law that God has given them. Stories are central to our life, and there is much to be learned from what our ancestors have experienced of the faithfulness of God The psalmist says that they are to pass on stories heard from the ancestors (1.3), and make sure that the children know them (v.4). In many ways we too are ignorant of the way our ancestors lived their lives in Christ, and what they learned about the faithfulness of God. Our sense of tradition may tend to be more about formal doctrines and creeds, and less about the stories of everyday saints. We need to recapture the stories that form us.
