Psalm 106:1-6, 19-23

The psalmist raises a very good question: "Who can proclaim the mighty acts of the Lord or declare all his praise?" (v.2). The Old Covenant answer was Those who act justly and always do what is right (v.3). Christianity is unique in its teaching that we cannot earn our way into God's favour. Rather, we are made righteous by the works of Jesus Christ, God's own Son God's chosen one stands in the breach for all of us. We may enter the wedding feast wearing the robes of righteousness that Jesus has given us. We simply accept what Jesus gives us. In response, we proclaim the mighty acts of the Lord and sing his praises. We seek to act justly and do what is right, but no longer in our own strength. We have been given the power of the Holy Spirit to enable us as we grow into the likeness of Jesus. There is beautiful simplicity in following Jesus, the difficulties come when we allow ourselves to complicate it On this Sabbath Day, the first day of the week, take time to enjoy the intimacy of the relationship Jesus gives us with our loving Creator. Proclaim the mighty acts of the Lord. Declare God's praise.
