## Psalm 1

The first psalm in the Psalter opens with words we all long to experience in our lives: "Happy" is a beatitude or a declaration that someone is living their best genuine, and most joyful life. When an individual is happy or blessed, the psalmist suggests, they may be compared with a tree that yields fruit in its season. (On the other hand, though, there is another way of life that is best likened to one being like leaves blown around by the wind!) How can we live the happy, blessed life? The psalmist acknowledges that there are two ways in life. There is the way of the righteous, which includes those who meditate and delight in the law of the LORD; and then there is the way of the wicked, who are slaves to sin. The psalmist does not put emphasis on following rules or regulations, but points us to God's intention for us to live a happy and joyful life. When we take time to meditate on the living word that is Jesus Christ, we soon find ourselves growing in God's love and bearing fruit that does not wither but only prospers. Today, let us reflect on which parts of our lives are flourishing like a tree planted by streams of water, and which parts are withering and in need of nourishment.
