Revelation 7:9-17

All Saints Day All Saints Day is always celebrated on 1 November, and so is not a "moveable feast". The celebration may seem strange to many Protestants (and even more so for scientific, rationalist people of the twenty-first century), and yet a sensitive reading of this passage will reveal resonances with some aspects of contemporary life. The scene portrays a vision of the throne of heaven surrounded by people from every corner of the earth (v 9). They wear white robes and wave palm branches and sing the praise of God, creating a festive atmosphere (v.12). In verse 13, an elder asks "me" (the observer). "Who are these, robed in white, and where have they come from?" The answer follows immediately: they are the martyred saints who have given their lives for the faith, and are now vindicated by their sharing in this indescribable festivity in the presence of God. The word "saints" in the New Testament has a wider meaning than "martyrs", so it is appropriate for us to use All Saints Day as a time to remember those who have preceded us in the faith—whether they are living or dead. We might also learn to give special thanks for modern martyrs, those often-unheralded saints whose numbers, regrettably, grow day by day.
